Travel Info from Madrid Barajas Airport (Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas) to Salamanca



Option 1: Direct from the Airport–Salamanca Bus (Monbus)

Route: The most convenient and direct option. Buses depart directly from **Terminal 1** and **Terminal 4 (Airport Terminal)** and take you to Salamanca's central bus station **without stops**.

Duration: Approximately 2 hours 30 minutes.

Departure times: 13:15 . 17:15 . 19:15 . 21:30

Advantage: No transfers inside Madrid, direct and non-stop.

Online booking: Monbus



Option 2: High-Speed Train: Madrid-Salamanca (from Chamartín Station)

Step 1: Getting to Chamartín Station from the airport:

Take Metro Line 8 from the airport to **Nuevos Ministerios**, then transfer to Metro Line 10 or Cercanías C1/C10 to **Chamartín**.

Travel time: approx. 30–40 minutes.

Step 2: High-speed train (AVE or Alvia) to Salamanca:

Duration: approx. 1 hour 50 minutes.

Online booking: Renfe

Advantage: Fastest option to reach Salamanca.







Option 3: Madrid-Salamanca Bus (from Méndez Álvaro Station)

Step 1: Getting to Méndez Álvaro bus station from the airport:

Take Metro Line 8 from the airport to **Nuevos Ministerios**, then transfer to Metro Line 6 (circular) to **Méndez Álvaro**.

Travel time: approx. 40 minutes.

Step 2: Direct bus Madrid–Salamanca (Avanza):

Buses run every 1–2 hours throughout the day.

Duration: approx. 2 hours 30 minutes.

Online booking: Avanza Bus



Option 4: Regular Train Madrid-Salamanca (from Príncipe Pío Station)

Step 1: Getting to Principe Pio Station from the airport:

Take Metro Line 8 from the airport to **Nuevos Ministerios**, then transfer to Line 10 to Príncipe Pío.

Travel time: approx. 35-45 minutes.

Step 2: Regional train (Media Distancia) Madrid-Salamanca:

Duration: Minimom . 2 hours 45 minutes.

Online booking: Renfe

Advantage: A more economical option compared to high-speed trains







Additional Travel Information

OMIO Booking Platform:

For convenience, participants can also use <u>Omio</u> to compare and book all available transport options (bus, train, or flight) between Madrid and Salamanca in one place.

Local Transport at Madrid Barajas Airport:

The airport is well connected with **city buses** (day and night services) as well as **official airport taxis** available 24/7 at all terminals. Taxis have a fixed fare to central Madrid, making it easy to reach bus or train stations if you choose Options 2, 3, or 4.



Important Note

- ◄ High-speed trains (AVE/Alvia) to Salamanca depart exclusively from Madrid Chamartín Station.
- ◄ Príncipe Pío Station serves only regular and regional trains, with travel times ranging from 2h 45m to 3h 45m, depending on the route.
- ▼ For bus travel, please note that in addition to the direct airport—Salamanca line, other bus services departing from Madrid city may include intermediate stops. This can extend the journey time to between 2h 45m and 3h 45m depending on the number of stops.
- NOTE: Madrid city buses do not allow large suitcases, so they are less convenient if you are traveling with heavy luggage.
- Taxi or Ride-Hailing Apps: Services such as Uber and Cabify are widely used. Alternatively, taxis are available at the airport exit.
